## Project Import (98.01)

- Project Imports was introduced in 1986 as a special mechanism for importing items of machinery required for the initial setting up or substantial expansion of eligible projects. As project imports, eligible items of imports are classified under a single heading (Heading 9801) and subjected to a single rate of duty, rather than the tariff rate having to be applied to each item separately. The types of projects covered under Heading 9801 include industrial plants, irrigation projects, power projects, mining projects, oil and mineral exploration projects, and other notified projects such as pipeline projects, railway and metro projects, LNG terminals, etc.
- Whereas the BCD rate in the Tariff for all goods under Heading 9801 is presently $10 \%$, different goods have been charged to lower BCD rates (nil or $2.5 \%$ or $5 \%$ ) under the respective exemption and lower rate notifications. As proposed, please see below the table encapsulating the methodology of determining the effective rate.
