Background

In 2021, 1.9 billion of Muslims worldwide spent an average of USD 2 trillion in food, pharmaceutical, cosmetics, fashion, travel, and media/recreation sectors, reflecting 8.9% y-o-y growth from 2020. Muslim expenditure on pharmaceuticals in 2021 increased 6.5% in 2021, from USD 93.5 billion to USD 100 billion, and is expected to grow by a further 6.7% in 2022 to USD 106 billion reach USD 129 billion in 2025 at a 4-year CAGR of 6.7%. Despite the uncertainties of the global economy due to the COVID-19 pandemic, Investment in Halal pharmaceutical production parks recorded an increase of 1.25 percent. This reflects the growing interest of investors towards Halal pharmaceutical and tech-based medical related products/services.

The Halal industry has been identified as a strategic and high-impact sector under the 12th Malaysia Plan. In line with our aspiration to promote Malaysia as a global halal hub, the Malaysian Friendship and Trade Centre (MFTC) is scheduled to organize an online seminar on "Malaysia: Spearing the Global Halal Medical Industry" on September 8th, 2022.
